1. Read *Genesis 3:1*. What can you learn from this verse about the nature of temptation and sin?
2. Read *Genesis 3: 2-5*. What can you learn about the nature of temptation and sin from the serpent's response to God's command?
3. Read *James 1:13-17*. Adam blamed Eve or God for his sin. Eve blamed the serpent. What did James say about God's relation to sin (see v.13)? What did he say about God's character and interaction with us (see v.17)?
4. Read *James 1:15*. In the beginning, God blessed Adam and Eve to be fruitful and multiply. How did James describe the reproductive process of evil?
5. Read *Romans 1:18-25* and summarize the human problem in personal terms. What happened to humanity's relationship with the Creator?
